The *Lagniappe Dulcimer Society* invites you to join us for the *Ninth Annual Lagniappe Dulcimer Fête* in Port Allen, Louisiana in March 2010. Due to space limitations, *all vendors must pre-register* and will be admitted on a first come basis.

Place: The fête will be held at the Port Allen Community Center, 749 N. Jefferson Ave. and The West Baton Rouge Museum that is located adjacent to the Community Center. Registration, vendors, jamming, meals and concerts will be held at the Community Center and the West Baton Rouge Museum is the site for workshop classes.

Vendor Booth Fees: Vendor registration fees are \$25.00 for each 6-foot table across the front of the booth and two chairs. You may reserve up to 4 tables.

Pre-fête festivities on Thursday evening: Bring your favorite dish to our get-acquainted supper at 5:30 pm.

Set-up Time: Booth set-up begins at **12.00 noon** Thursday afternoon on March 12.

Vendor Ending Time: Vendors may take their booths down any time after 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 14, 2009. Some vendors may wish to remain open for concert business. In any case, please do not disassemble booths **during** the concert due to noise.

Vendor Camping: There are some camping spots next to the Community Center with water and electricity. **These spots are on a first come, first serve basis for a fee of \$15.00 per night payable upon arrival. Reservations are not accepted.** Campers are advised to arrive during regular business hours.
